The **Gospel of John** was the last of the Gospels to be written.

The word for **Spirit** in Greek also means wind or breath.

The story of "Doubting Thomas" is only told in the Gospel of John.

Another way to translate *doubt* in this story is **"unbelieving."** Jesus says, "Do not be unbelieving, but believing!" to Thomas.

The disciples were all **hiding** in a locked room when Jesus came because they were afraid.

It was **dangerous** to be a follower of Jesus in that time and place.
