Over the past several months, Facebook has been making numerous changes with their live streaming platform, specifically with how long they will keep live streaming recordings, as well as where you are able to watch live streams. Starting on April 12, 2025, instead of streaming on Facebook Live, we will instead be streaming exclusively on our St. John YouTube channel.

This will offer lots of benefits, including the ability to attend our services without having to be signed in with an account, as well as the ability to watch our services on the big screen in your house once again! All Smart TVs have the ability to install the YouTube app, so you can attend worship on a much larger format.

If you do have a Google Account (which most people do), you can then Subscribe to our channel and turn on notifications whenever our services go live. That way, you never miss a thing.


