1942-2025

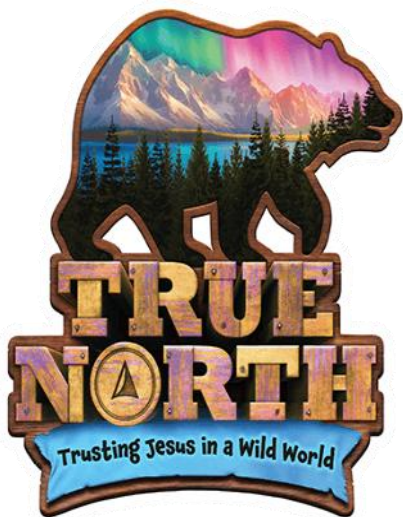
