pē-kē pronuncation Pick-key / Pick-key
A motorbike or motorcycle, often used to transport
people, goods and even the Word of God! A common term
used in many African countries, particularly in East Africa.

| The ministry of more than 170 evangelists in the
Dodoma Diocese in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in
Tanzania is strengthened when transported by PIKIPIKI,
saving miles of walking and increasing time in service
and care to God's people in remote parishes. |

85% of evangelists in the Dodoma Diocese of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania serve remote communities, often walking 12-20 miles between parishes to preach, provide worship leadership and pastoral care to multiple communities of faith. This summer, the Global Mission Board of the Northwestern Ohio Synod will match gifts made towards the purchase of pikipikis dollar for dollar! \$1600 buys one motorcycle with regular maintenance and makes ministry more accessible for one evangelist in Tanzania.

This year our Vacation Bible School offering will be used to support Project Pikipiki. With the help of the congregation, we hope to raise enough money to provide a a Pikipiki to support the ministry of our brothers and sisters in Tanzania.
