Breakfast Gatherings have moved to the McDonald's in **Genoa**! So, join us Weds. morning at 7 AM for food and fellowship!





4:05 PM Mud Hens Game on Sunday August 11th as the Mud Hens take on the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp!




We will gather at 7:00 pm.
